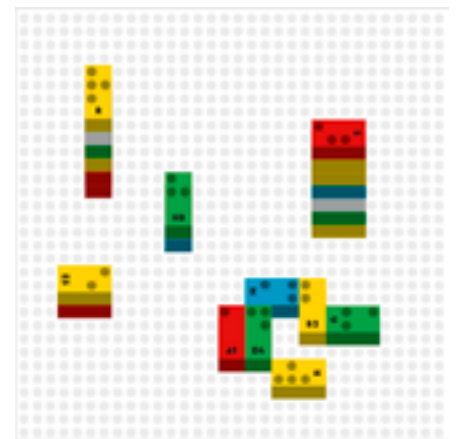
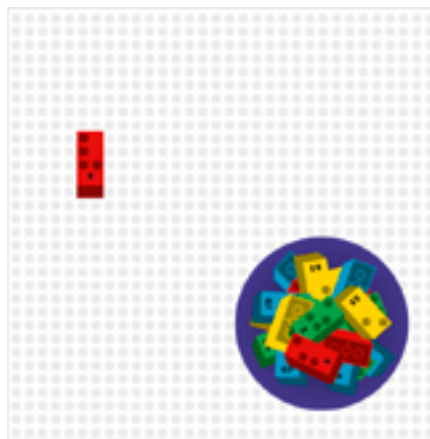

## Will you build a village, a town, or a whole city?

Let your imagination run wild. Stack bricks to create houses and buildings, imagine streets and parks. Then play in your city!

### Goals

To manipulate bricks, to build different types of structures.  
To express creative ideas.



### The adult prepares

- 1 toolkit
- 1 baseplate

### The children play

- 1 The child picks a brick from the box and attaches it to the baseplate.

Is it the beginning of a house, a building, a street?

- 2 They add other bricks, to build a big city that can be seen from far away!

Ask the child to give a guided tour of their city.

### Facilitation tips

- Ask the children about where they grew up.
- Compare and discuss the size and types of buildings.
- Give the children minifigures to play with in their city.
- Include several children in the activity, using multiple baseplates, so that the children can build a giant city together.
